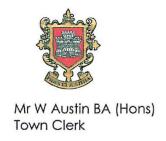

Comments

A surplus was made last year – majority is raised through funding. 78% of expenditure on personnel costs. 2013/2014 accounts submitted; have emailed for latest accounts.

A loss was made last year – Majority of income through ticketed events. Bulk of expenditure on rent/musician payments, insurance and draw prizes. Have 7 months' worth of running costs in savings/reserves.

A loss was made last year – Income primarily from concerts. Bulk of expenditure on hiring and band master. Have a year's worth of running costs in savings/reserves.

A slight surplus was made last year – majority of income is from performances and other. Bulk of expenditure is vehicles and other. A slight surplus was made last year – majority of income is from gifts and donations.

A surplus was made last year – majority is raised through grants/donations. A surplus was made last year – majority is raised through grants. 52% of expenditure on personnel costs. 2013/2014 accounts submitted; have emailed for latest accounts.

No accounts supplied, have emailed and asked for accounts or evidence to back up figures supplied.

A loss was made last year – Majority of income through fees/funds. 60% of expenditure wages and salaries.

Balance sheet only supplied. The organisation advises that it produce an abbreviated form of accounts which does not include an income and expenditure statement. The balance sheet shows an increase in reserves over the year, so they are generating a surplus. As a not-for-profit organisation such surpluses should be kept to a minimum and Parkrun say they do this.

A slight surplus was made last year – Majority of income from subs, donations and grants. Bulk of expenditure on travel and hire costs.
